Located in the historic Schei district of Brasov, the house blends traditional Transylvanian character with contemporary sensitivity. We drew on local materials — scale-patterned clay tiles, wood, and copper — the latter referencing Brasov's blacksmith guild and appearing both outside and in refined interior finishes.


During the renovation, we discovered original 19th-century beams, some signed by their makers, which will be restored and integrated into the new design. Though structurally rebuilt almost entirely, the house retains its identity through these subtle connections to place.

A few 'American style' touches reflect the client's Texan background, completing a natural dialogue between heritage and personal story.

The project also responds to challenging constraints: a dense urban context, structural decay, limited sunlight, and a striking hillside view we chose to embrace.
