Kulla Prishtina is a striking new addition to the urban fabric of Prishtina, designed by Maden Group as a bold reinterpretation of vertical living. The project is a mixed-use residential complex that redefines the city skyline through its sculptural form, innovative geometry, and dynamic massing.

The tower's composition is characterized by stacked volumes that shift and taper as they ascend, creating a visually compelling silhouette. Each volume is carefully rotated and cantilevered, offering both architectural drama and functional outdoor spaces like terraces and sky gardens.

The lower levels house commercial and social functions, contributing to the urban vibrancy of the area and promoting street-level interaction. As the structure rises, it transitions into residential units, with panoramic glazing that maximizes natural light and offers expansive views over the city. The use of dark-toned cladding paired with warm interior lighting creates a refined and modern aesthetic, while the red accent recesses inject a sense of energy and playfulness.

Sustainable urban living is central to the design, with green elements subtly integrated into various levels of the structure. Kulla Prishtina is not only a residential tower; it's a vertical neighborhood—an ambitious architectural statement that reflects Maden Group's progressive vision for the future of living in Prishtina.
